Best Practice Guidance When Fishing Around Flamborough Head

Be Aware:

The seabirds nesting on these cliffs are protected*

Please remember to...

- **Use high visibility materials** - seabirds can become tangled in fishing line.
- **Take all fishing tackle and litter home with you**, even if it's not yours, or use bins provided.
- **Ensure that your tackle comprises of a minimum 30lb BS mainline:** terminal tackle to incorporate a rotten bottom and a minimum 50lb BS leader to be used with any means of casting.
- **Ensure your safety, and that of others, at all times.**
